Syrma SGS Elemaster Inaugurates New High-Reliability Electronics Manufacturing Facility in Bengaluru





20,000 sq. ft. facility equipped with advanced SMT, THT and box-build capabilities to serve railways, transportation, industrial, energy and medical electronics markets

Bengaluru, September 2, 2026: Syrma SGS Technology (BSE: SYRMA; NSE: INE0DYJ01015) and Italy-based Elemaster Group have inaugurated a new state-of-the-art high-reliability electronics manufacturing facility in Bengaluru through their joint venture, Syrma SGS Elemaster Private Limited.

Located in the Bommasandra Industrial Area, the 20,000 sq. ft. facility is designed to strengthen India's capabilities in high-reliability electronics manufacturing and support customers across domestic and international markets. The facility brings together advanced Surface Mount Technology (SMT), Through-Hole Technology (THT) and box-build assembly capabilities under one roof.

Key sectors to be served include railways and transportation, industrial electronics, energy and medical electronics, while also enabling the joint venture to support global OEMs through a Made-in-India manufacturing platform.
