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Syrma SGS-Elmaster opens electronics manufacturing facility in Bengaluru

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SYNOPSIS

Syrma SGS Technology and Italy-based Elmaster Group have opened a 20,000 square feet electronics manufacturing facility in Bengaluru through their joint venture, Syrma SGS Elmaster Private Ltd. Located in the Bommasandra Industrial Area, the facility has been set up with an initial investment of INR 55 crore and is expected to generate around INR 200 crore in revenue in its first full year of operations in FY28. The plant has surface mount technology, through-hole technology and box-build assembly lines and will serve sectors including railways, transportation, industrial electronics, energy and medical electronics.

Syrma SGS Technology and Elmaster Group have inaugurated a high-reliability electronics manufacturing facility in Bengaluru through their joint venture, Syrma SGS Elmaster Private Ltd. The facility is located in the Bommasandra Industrial Area and has an area of 20,000 square feet.

The facility has been established with an initial investment of INR 55 crore. Syrma SGS expects the joint venture to generate around INR 200 crore in revenue in its first full year of operations in FY28, according to executive chairman Sandeep Tandon.

The plant is equipped with Surface Mount Technology (SMT), Through-Hole Technology (THT) and box-build assembly lines. It will manufacture electronics for sectors including railways and transportation, industrial electronics, energy and medical electronics, while also supporting domestic and global original equipment manufacturers.

The joint venture brings together Syrma SGS's manufacturing scale, supply-chain network and execution capabilities in India with Elmaster's electronics design and engineering expertise and its relationships with European and global OEMs.

Syrma SGS and Elmaster had entered into their joint venture agreement in 2025 to create an India-focused platform for high-reliability electronics manufacturing. The facility was planned with an initial footprint of about 20,000 square feet at Bommasandra.

Syrma SGS managing director Jasbir Singh Gujral said the combination of SMT, THT and box-build capabilities at one facility would allow the joint venture to handle complex electronics manufacturing requirements for railways, industrial and medical applications.

Elmaster CEO Valentina Cogliati said the Bengaluru facility would provide a base for the company's growing opportunities in India as well as support its global customer base. The companies are also looking to use the facility to manufacture products for both

Indian and overseas customers.

The inauguration was attended by Giandomenico Milano, Consul General of Italy in Bengaluru, along with representatives from Syrma SGS, Elmaster, customers and other stakeholders.

The new facility comes as electronics manufacturing in India is expanding beyond large-scale assembly into areas requiring specialised design, engineering and high-reliability manufacturing capabilities. Syrma SGS has also continued to expand its partnerships in the electronics manufacturing sector, including a separate joint venture with Japan-based Kaga Electronics announced in the past year to focus on manufacturing for Japanese clients.
